

**Archery**: Learn about this fast growing sport. Do you want to learn backyard recreation, competitive target shooting, or maybe you want to go bow hunting? You will learn how to select equipment that fits you. There will be lots of hands-on instruction. Experience the thrill of hitting the target!

**Birdwatching**: What was that little brown ball of feathers? Join us in exploring the fun of bird watching. Learn to identify different types of birds and discuss equipment selection for successful bird watching. This class will spend time out in the field identifying local birds.

**Cake Decorating**: Learn how to ice a cake and the basic decorating skills. Learn how to make flowers and designs and how to write on cakes.

<u>Dutch Oven Cooking</u>: Food always tastes better when it's cooked outside. Don't go hungry in the outdoors! This session covers methods, equipment, and recipes for delighted tummies.

**First Aid**: A little rusty on your "ABC's" of first aid. Forget where the pressure points are? What's the difference between heat stroke and heat exhaustion and how do you treat each? What do you do if you encounter a venomous snake? This class will help to refresh your skills.

**Fishing**: Develop basic skills needed to catch fish: casting, knot tying, lure selection, fish identification, fishing locations, and equipment choice and use.

<u>Gardening</u>: Learn how to plan and grow an exciting backyard wildlife garden that will attract hummingbirds, butterflies, birds, and even some bigger critters- if you want them. Water gardens, plants, feeders, and other ideas will be presented to help you develop a nurturing habitat for your wildlife neighbors as well as for your senses. <u>(additional \$5 class</u> <u>supply fee required)</u>

**Handguns**: Participants will learn the proper handling of handguns, shooting positions, and basic shooting techniques. There will be plenty of practice time.

<u>Outdoor Cooking</u>: Learn to make fabulous meals over the open fire! Whether you use foil packs, or a stick, you can enjoy a great meal outdoors!

**Scrapbooking**: Do you have a box of photos from your family vacations or holidays and don't know what to do to get your scrapbook started, well here's the class for you. Please be sure to bring along several photos that you would like to work with. (additional \$5 class supply fee required)

**Stream Ecology**: This class will be in introduction to aquatic creatures and their role in an aquatic ecosystem. There will be some lecture time, but most of the class will involve hands-on learning, so be prepared to get wet. Participants should bring old shoes.

**Talk to the Animals**: Birds and mammals have languages of their own. If you'd like to begin to get a handle on what they are "saying", you should join this group. We'll learn about both vocal and non-vocal sounds made by Pennsylvania wildlife. We will also show you how to assemble and use your own Mourning Dove call. This will be a "hands on" session.

**Trap Shooting**: You will become familiar with different types of shotguns, ammunition, and proper gun fitting. Time will be spent at the range where you will shoot clay birds.

**Wildlife Habitats**: Ever wonder what game and non-game animals live in your area? Join us to find the clues that Pennsylvania birds and mammals leave behind to tell where they've been and what they've been doing. You'll probably be surprised at what you've been missing!
